- 1. THE EVENT** will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of CAMS, the Speed Event Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations that may be issued and approved by CAMS. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.

- 3. THE EVENT** will be conducted as a **Club Hillclimb** Event under CAMS Permit No: **219/2605/02**

- 8. ENTRIES:**
Entries will open upon publication of these Regulations. Close at: 5 p.m. on Thursday 23rd May 2019.
No late entries will be accepted.
Maximum number of driver entries for the Event: **40**
Entries will be accepted on a "first in" basis. The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any competitor in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
Maximum number of drivers per vehicle: **2**

9. ENTRY FEE:

Entry fee will be: **\$80 for adults and \$40 for Juniors**. In the event a Competitor **withdraws before 8pm on the Thursday before the event** then the Entry Fee will be refunded or credited towards the next event – less an Administration Fee of \$20.

10. MINIMUM LICENCES:

Current CAMS Level 2S/2SJ Licence and CMHAC membership are compulsory and must be produced at the event.

11. EVENT FORMAT:

SCRUTINY will be held at the **CMHAC Clubhouse, Bolaro Rd Cooma, from 7:00 am to 8:45 am**. **Trailer vehicles may be scrutineered at the hillclimb at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer**

a) All vehicles must comply with Schedules A & B of the CAMS General Requirements for Automobiles (as specified in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport), including a fire extinguisher, blue triangle for battery location and a secondary method for fastening the bonnet. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

b) Competition Numbers are to be positioned on both sides of the vehicle. **A competition number card will be issued to competitors at registration and must be returned at the end of the event.**

c) Drivers and vehicles must be presented in a clean and tidy manner. It is the drivers' responsibility to ensure their vehicles are scrutineered before the scheduled start time of the event. Drivers must attend scrutineering personally so their driving apparel can be checked. Competitors must produce a valid and current CAMS Competition Licence and Club Membership Card and Log Book (if issued) at document check/scrutiny.

DRIVERS' BRIEFING will be held at the start line at 9:00 am pm. It is compulsory for **ALL** drivers to attend.

Note: A **driver sign on sheet must be signed by all drivers** as evidence of briefing attendance; failure to sign on may result in penalties being applied by the Stewards of the meeting.

The EVENT commences at 9:30 pm and finishes by 4:00 pm.

12. VEHICLE CATEGORIES AND CLASSES:

The organisers may re-classify any vehicle if they believe it is not eligible for the category/type or class in which it has been entered. **Eligible vehicles will be: Type 1, 2, 3, 4, AWD/SV types 1-4 and type AE.**

13. FUEL:

All competitors are permitted to use fuel as defined in Schedule G in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. **Vehicles running on alcohol** shall have signage indicating the use as is prescribed in Schedule G, Item 5.3

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS (CONT)

14. DRIVER SAFETY:

Drivers must wear apparel as outlines in Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, including:

- a) A helmet that complies with AS 1698 or better (as per current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport) and carries markings to that effect or is otherwise specifically approved by CAMS.
- b) Non-flammable clothing, including cover from throat to wrists to ankles (apparel of nylon or similar material is forbidden). Flame retardant overalls, or better, are highly recommended.
- c) Suitable flame retardant footwear. Thongs, open sandals, high heeled shoes and nylon joggers are forbidden)
- d) In open cars, goggles or a visor with a lens material other than glass (to AS 1609) are mandatory. Leather or Nomex gloves which entirely cover hands are strongly recommended.
- e) CMHAC strongly recommends that convertible vehicles (whether road registered or not) be fitted with a ROPS. It is further recommended that such vehicles compete with the soft top down and the driver wear appropriate protection as in d) above.

15. REPLACEMENT VEHICLES:

At the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course, a driver whose vehicle has broken down may use a replacement vehicle. The replacement vehicle must have been scrutineered, and preferably be in the same category/type and class as the original vehicle. Where the original vehicle has recorded a time and the scrutineered replacement vehicle is not in the same category/type and class as the original vehicle, the replacement vehicle will not be eligible for prizes and/or trophies.

16. TIMING EQUIPMENT:

Timing will be with an accuracy of **0.01 second (1/100th)**

17. RERUNS:

Reruns will be permitted at the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course. A restart will only be permitted if the rear wheels have not crossed the start line, if a red flag is displayed on the hill or a timing error occurs.

18. PENALTIES:

Penalties may be imposed by the Stewards upon any competitor who has been considered in breach of any of the standing rules or regulations, or who has been deemed to have demonstrated unsafe behaviour. The penalties could range from removal of the time for a run to exclusion from the event.

Time penalties may also be imposed for hitting marker cones.

19. AWARDS:

Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the event at the venue.

Trophies will be presented for all classes that contain at least 3 competitors, as well as a trophy for FTD.

20. AUTHORITY OF OFFICIALS:

Any driver not following a reasonable instruction by an official during the event may be excluded from the event at the discretion of the Stewards of the Meeting.

23. INSURANCE:

24. PROTESTS:

Any protests must be made in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

25. POSTPONEMENT/ABANDONMENT/CANCELLATION:

The organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

26. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES:

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

27. REFRESHMENT FACILITIES:

Refreshment facilities will be available on site; alternate facilities are available in Cooma or nearby Service Stations.

28. ADDITIONS AND/OR ALTERATIONS:

Any additions and/or alterations to these Supplementary Regulations will be notified to all drivers in **Further Regulations** or during the **Drivers' Briefing**.
